HOW TO ENTER: Please send **notice of your intent to enter** the contest by either mail or e-mail:

MAIL - Send a 3x5 card with your printed name, address, phone number and e-mail address if you have internet access. Mail the card to Lumberyard Arts Center, P.O. Box 523, Baldwin City, KS 66006. The card must say "Cobbler Contest Entry."

In the subject line, please put "Cobbler Contest Entry."
Include in the e-mail text your name, address, and phone number.

WHEN TO ENTER: Mailed or e-mail notices must be received by **September 24, 2011.**

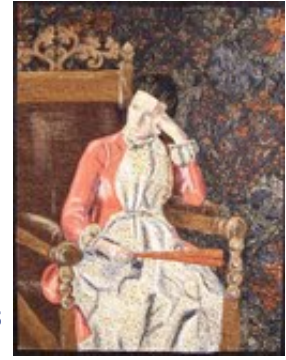
Contestants must deliver their fruit cobbler in a 9 x 13 (or larger) disposable pan by 4 pm on **Saturday, October 1** to the Lumberyard Arts Center, 718 High Street, Baldwin City, KS. Judging will take place immediately. Winning cobblers will be identified and prizes awarded shortly after judging is completed. The entered cobblers will be served to the Bluegrass & BBQ attendees starting at 5:30 p.m. that evening.

JUDGING: Judging will be based on appearance, flavor and texture. The Lumberyard Arts Center will furnish judges and prizes for contestants. Entries will be identified by number only prior to judging. All decisions of the judges are final.

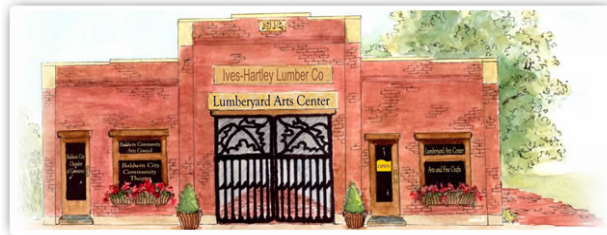
DON'T MISS THIS STUNNING EXHIBIT

An Art Quilt is a piece of highly collectible artwork. It isn't designed to be used on a bed like a traditional quilt, but is meant to be hung on a wall like a painting. Artists use fiber as their medium and may dye, paint, cut, tear or fuse the fabric or other fibers as part of their work. The pieces may be embellished with beads, buttons, photos, or found objects.
