October 11th-Barbara Pressgrove & Richard Wellman.

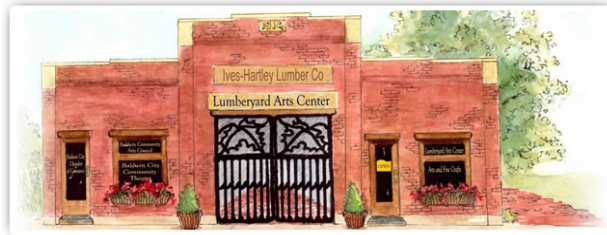
