A long-time Baldwin resident, he works as a seasonal park ranger for the National Park Service and has been a photographer for the National Forest Service as well. For the past summer, he was a photographer for the University of Montana Avian Science Center.

Photography has been an important medium for Ken for many years. Taking nature photographs allows him to express his creativity. "Photographs capture things that inspire me," he says. "To document nature's beauty in a photograph is the best way to hold and record a moment in time, and we are able to re-live that moment every time we look at it."

Ken has a bachelor's degree from Emporia State University and has taught photography classes at Kansas City Kansas Community College and Johnson County Community College. Many of Ken's photographs are in private collections around the country.

The show's opening reception will be Friday, October 26 from 6 to 8 p.m. and will run through November 17th.
