Gallery Reception-Jim Sallenbach

The Lumberyard Arts Center will host a new exhibit with an artist's reception on Friday, September 21st from 7-9 p.m. "Object-ive Vision" by Jim Sallenbach, an accomplished self-taught artist, will include several works inspired by the Lumberyard Arts Center, with some pieces crafted from found objects from the unfinished portion of the building.

Sallenbach takes ordinary and often discarded objects and turns them into thought-provoking individual pieces of art. His works are primarily mixed media on paper collage, mixed media sculpture and repurposing of found objects. He has exhibited works in several area galleries, including Lawrence, Ottawa, Paola, and El Dorado, KS. Sallenbach has also exhibited in Long Beach, Los Angeles, and San Francisco, CA.

The show will continue through Friday, October 19th during regular gallery hours of 1-4p.m. Tuesday-Friday; 9a.m.-12p.m. Saturday. The exhibit will also be on display the weekend of October 20-21 for the Maple Leaf Festival.
