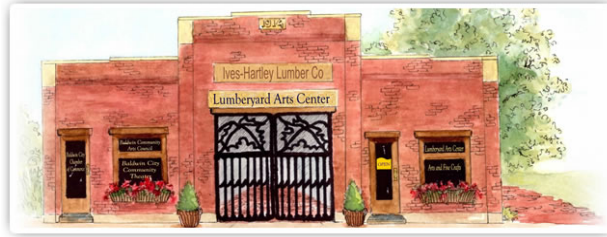
- There is **NO ENTRY FEE**.

- The fruit cobbler must be in a 9x13 or larger pan. Non-disposable pans must be clearly marked with owner's name and phone number.
- Entries will be judged on appearance, taste, and texture.
- The Lumberyard Arts Center will provide the judges.
- Prizes awarded for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place winners.
- All decisions of the judges are final.
- All entries will be served to those attending Bluegrass & BBQ beginning at 5:30 p.m.
